

The Houston Chapter of the Texas Association of Sports Officials (TASO), Football Division, is offering financial support to deserving qualifying students in pursuit of higher education.

Instructions:

- 1. Complete the application at the end of this document (including the essay) in either black ink or typed, and submit by email before April 20, 2021.
- 2. Submit an official high school transcript.
- 3. Submit two (2) written letters of recommendation on the letterhead of the author, with an original signature and contact information.

Additional Information:

- The Chapter anticipates awarding ten (10) scholarships.
- Eligible students must (i) be a graduating senior from a public, private, parochial, charter or home school serviced by the Houston TASO Football Chapter, and (ii) be awarded a high school football player, football trainer, or football manager.
- The applicant must be pursuing a two- or four-year degree at a postsecondary institution.
- The applicant may NOT be attending college on an athletic scholarship.
- Only ONE student per school will be eligible for a scholarship award.
- Applicants should demonstrate aptitude at extracurricular activities, community involvement, volunteerism, and citizenship.
- The majority of the scholarships will be a one-time stipend of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
- One scholarship may be a one-time stipend of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) that is awarded to an applicant who is a relative of a member in good standing of the Houston TASO Football Chapter (the Sam Brown Memorial Scholarship).



- The scholarship funds will be issued by the Houston TASO Football Chapter to the bursar of the postsecondary institution that the applicant will attend.
- The scholarship recipients will be determined by the Houston TASO Football Chapter Scholarship Committee, which is headed by the Division IV Board Representative and consists of a minimum of four (4) other Chapter members in good standing.
- Scholarship recipients will be selected by May 15, 2021, and notified shortly thereafter.
